

PENC Legislative Update

The Facts about “Registration and Voting at One-Stop Sites”

WHO:

You must be a US citizen and by Election Day, you must be at least 18 years old and have lived in the county at least 30 days.

WHEN:

You can use “Same Day Registration” only in the Early Voting Period from 19 to 3 days before an Election, *but not on Election Day*.

- ▶ April 17 to May 3 for the May 6 Primary Election
- ▶ Oct. 18 to Nov. 3 for the Nov. 6 General Election

HOW:

1. Go to an Early Voting Site in your county

(Visit <http://www.sboe.state.nc.us/content.aspx?id=17> to find your one stop site.)

2. Fill out the registration form

3. Show the official one of these documents with your name and your current address:

- ▶ NC driver’s license
- ▶ Bank or bank-card statement
- ▶ An electric, gas, phone, water, or cable bill
- ▶ Paycheck or paycheck stub or W-2 form
- ▶ Student ID & school document with your address
- ▶ A document from a government agency, such as:
 - ◆ Car registration, tax bill, license to hunt, fish, etc.
 - ◆ Social Security, Medicare, Medicaid card or letter
 - ◆ Military ID, passport, other government ID
 - ◆ Letter, invoice, etc., from any government agency

4. Receive your ballot and cast your vote.
